Dear Douzelage friends,

During the GM in Skofja Loka in August 2022 a discussion arose on how to vote in general during sessions of the GM and particularly in the case of elections. (Constitution Douzelage, 4. Organisation, point c.)

We then agreed that the topic would be postponed and that the Presidency would present a few alternative proposals.

This document presents, as agreed during the GM of 2022, alternative amendments on the voting procedure in the constitution. The Presidency will add their considerations (annex 1) to this document for the sake of transparancy, in line with their point of view as communicated during the 2022 GM.

The procedure will be as follows:

This document with three proposed alternative amendments to the constitution of Douzelage will reach you two months prior to the 2023 GM in Rovinj/Rovigno.

We would like your written comments, if any, before the end of August 2023.

Your comments will be used to draw up a final document that will be voted upon during the 2023 GM. It will be sent to you two weeks before the 2023 GM.

(The voting procedure on this topic during the 2023 GM will be according to the constitution as is.)

Legal advice in the matter was given by Thorsten Wohleser and Wolfgang Kerscher.

This led to three variations for the voting procedure:

- Each delegation may cast one vote in the GM, one vote in the EM and one vote in the YM.
   Note: In this case, we have to define the role of the second delegate of each member town in GM and YM.
- Each member town may delegate two persons in the GM, one person in the EM and two persons in the YM.
   Each delegate can cast one vote in the respective meeting.
  - Note: If only one person is delegated per town, then that town has only one vote.
- Each member town may cast two votes in the GM, one vote in the EM and two votes in the YM. If only one delegate from a member town is present in the GM or YM, that vote counts double.

Annex 1.

The Presidency prefers the third variation because of the following considerations:

#### Fairness and representation

More votes ensure a more equal distribution of power and influence within the organization and provide them with a stronger voice in decision-making processes.

A member town that can only send one delegate should have the right to cast two votes.

#### Inclusivity and collaboration, active engagement

More votes per town encourages greater. It fosters a sense of belonging and motivates delegates to actively engage in discussions, negotiations, and finding common ground.

#### Fostering consensus

In certain situations, having more votes per town can make it easier and more flexible to reach consensus on controversial matters. If a proposal receives support from multiple delegates, it is likely to be more widely accepted and respected and it also ensures a larger democratic participation.

Trip to the Šunmava mountains and a trip to Prague (for those who will arrive to Prague earlier)

#### Accommodation:

Garni Hotel Roušarka - 5 nights + full board

#### Transport:

Transport to Prague at own expense of the participants, transport from Prague provided by the organizer
